

"Are you willing to be Broken?"

Utterance by Pastor Bitely, Sept. 4, 2009

Are you willing to be broken? Are you willing to put your life, your body, your soul and your spirit totally into My hands? And will you allow Me to break you? Will you allow Me to take you and take out those things that have gotten into your life, into your mind and even into your body and into your heart? Things that defile. Things that cause you to stumble. Things that cause you to doubt. Things that cause you to even leave My Presence, saith the Lord. You will not be the same. You will not even think the same. Your attitude will not even be the same. Prior attitudes will be removed and be replaced and you will hunger for Me and you will hunger for My Presence and you will hunger for My Word, and you will hunger for My Spirit and you will not be able to be satisfied because of the intense hunger and you will come and you will fall on your face and cry out to Me, saying: Father, I hunger for you. Fill me now. I thirst for you. Fill me now. I long for you. Fill me now. And yea I will come. And yeah he that is hungry, shall be filled. And he that is thirsty, their thirst shall be quenched. And those that are so empty, and so loney, will never know loneliness and emptiness again for My fullness will be there.
